# A new idea for a Memorial Area

Another concept has been offered.

1. Refurbish the stone circle area (enlarge slightly, create seating, install fieldstone "floor").
2. Rework/replace the stone path from the breezeway down to the stone circle to make it complete, safe, and accessible.
3. Recreate the planting bed against the wall of the Community Room as a sustainable garden. Plant a tree (or two or three) by the stone circle.
4. Eventually, by some means (multiple ideas still to be considered), place plaques at the garden area.

This concept would enhance existing locations rather than install a new site. It would unify and give purpose to three separate, adjacent things.
